We welcome advice and support from independent experts in the wider community.

We commit to the implementation of the Diocesan Safeguarding Policy for Children and Adults at Risk.  
Implementing the procedures and practices of this Safeguarding Policy is essential in addressing and preventing abuse in our Parish.

All disclosures, allegations or concerns involving abuse or harm are taken seriously, treated with sensitivity and confidentiality, and reported, as required, to relevant authorities, civil and Church.

We want our young people to be safe, respected and heard, and to flourish.  
We want adults at risk to be respected and empowered in their decision-making, participation and well-being.

Safeguarding Children, Young People and Adults at Risk is the responsibility of every person in our Parish community.
